Changes in curriculum / syllabus

The ministry of education made changes in learning institutions to enable the children cover the syllabus in good time and to be able to grasp every detail. To this effect, the normal thirteen 13 weeks of learning in a every semester were stretched to sixteen 16. This means children will have to stay longer than usual in school but have a break in between the semester.

Holiday tuition

Holiday tuition were not affected, these enabled a child to polish in subjects he/she didn't perform well as the teacher has quality time for each child.

Delays

Due to this changes children delayed to receive report forms in good time to present to me as usual leading to this delay.

Performance

We noticed a good performance in almost all the children this being a start of a new semester as children join new grades; however some maintained their previous scores. Changes in the new syllabus may have been another factor towards their performance and to some it was a normal adjustment. We look forward to see them pick progressively. In general most were above average. Sickness among children also contributed to some not performing to their expectations. Poor living conditions and psycho-social needs especially to the children who come school every day is an issue to address children are poorly housed all in a two roomed house thus are prone to diseases and infections. While at home, children are idle and easily influenced by peer pressure.

Recommendations

The children who go to and from school can be provided with a better house free from infectious diseases such as malaria and typhoid ...this will help reduce cost on medication

There is need to have a church close to them so that counseling and spiritual matters are to be addressed as we offer close supervision to avoid bad groups and peer pressure. **I need at this point your input as well as your support to get started**
