

Gabriel's Promise – Update!

Gabriels Promise is now in it's second year of providing room and board and school tuition for 12 Sudanese refugees. The children are thriving, and their grades while good continue to improve with one of the boys being ranked first in his class and another being awarded a accounting internship at Kitale District Hospital in Kitale, Kenya.

To take all these children out of a one room house sheltering 16 people sleeping on a dirt floor, some days not eating a single meal, to providing new clothes, warm beds, 3 meals a day and a private school education is an amazing testament that anything is possible with God and with your generous giving.

In the report, and comments back from the children, you can see the children still have the needs we have been serving and new ones. Specifically we found out the children want to have milk at school with their meals. Much like needing milk money to have milk at our schools here in the US it is the same Kenya. If you recall after the first year of the program we learned the tuition did not include school books and corrected that, so we continue to learn and improve the program.

This program is very special and different from others in it's transparency. In the coming pages you will see the actual letter and report we received from Pastor Isaac our program monitor on the ground in Kenya. In the past we found out from Adera Foundation that Pastor Isaac had sold some of his goats to pay for doctor bills for the children never asking to be reimbursed. (we bought replacement goats & sent a tithe) So when Pastor Isaac expresses in his letter of his need for a computer so he doesn't have to pay computer rental time at an internet café to create and send the reports, we feel the need probably is great and we should see if we can meet it.

As you know the program cost last year were \$10,000. This year they are slightly more so we can meet some more of these basic needs. Please read Pastor Isaac's Report, the children's comments, look at their report cards and see the budget on the last 3 pages.

Your personal monetary donation goes a long way to help these children and it is greatly appreciated. Also, many of the children have asked for Bible Study material so if you have an appropriate Bible Study we would love to mail it to one or several of the children. Remember this tax deductible program will take about 10 years to fulfill.

* Gabriel is one of what the world named, **“The Lost Boys of the Sudan”**. Gabriel and thousands of other boys walked across the Sahara Dessert fleeing the genocide to refuge camps in Ethiopia. The story doesn't stop there. A civil war then broke out in Ethiopia causing the Lost Boys to then have to walk to refuge camps Kenya for safety. After several years in the Kenyan camp Gabriel was one of the lucky ones who was allowed to immigrate to the United States. Gabriel is now a proud American citizen, works full time for Catholic Charities, full time student in TWU and attends Christ Chapel Bible Church. It was Gabriel's promise to his nieces and nephews that brought about the Gabriel's Promise program. All donations are tax deductible through the Adera Foundation.

We have two young boys who are interested to be intercepted in this programme Abraham Akech and Amol Akech.

They go to a nearby school which doesn't offer quality Education as compared to the rest of the Schools their brothers go to. They are actually younger brothers to Gabriel. Kindly request for your assistance, they are just but among many who desire your assistance. Consider as God opens doors to help them.

Most Students have turned teenagers, as you will find from their report, they need guiding and counseling while away from School. They stay in a challenging environment with a lot of influence from their peers hence get easily carried away from right norms. Please consider getting them a better environment to stay in, they share two tiny rooms together with their younger sisters. You can imagine the situation.

While at break away from school, they have nothing to occupy them, can you please think of initiating a productive/creative programme to occupy them to avoid idleness and boredom hence acquire some skills.

Most Schools are offering Computer programmes of which it would be ideal for students. Please consider to help them learn.

Finally let us know if you wish to provide them with milk next Semester. I request you make arrangements to provide them with Bible study materials to raise their faith.

I didn't receive any operation money to run the programme last Semester and if you could help with the cost of a computer to create these reports it would be a great help.

God bless everyone who willfully has invested in these noble lives.






